Formal living room has the original stone fireplace which was used for cooking and stairs to the 4th bedroom. The traditional dining room has crown moulding and a stone wood burning fireplace. Updated country kitchen with an abundance of 42" cabinetry, pantry, hardwood woods, upgraded appliances and amazing views of the back yard. Breakfast area open to the kitchen with built-ins, hardwoods and beautiful views. Morning/sun room has French doors to the driveway and back yard.



The family room has a wall of built-ins, hardwoods, powder room, separate front entrance and back staircase to the upper level. The upper level features four generous sized bedrooms including a wonderful master bedroom suite with breathtaking views, hardwoods, private bath with deep silled window and dressing area with his and hers closets. Laundry room is conveniently located on the second level. The second bedroom has a private bath and the third bedroom has a stone fireplace with mantle and shares a hall bath with the fourth bedroom. Stairs lead to the floored attic, perfect for additional storage.

Impressive stone exterior has a metal roof complete with snow birds. New two zone air conditioning with heat pump and propane hot water baseboard heat.
